State Solicits Ideas for Reuse of Dobrowsky House

The Judicial Council of California is soliciting ideas from the private sector and non-profit organizations for relocating and reusing the historic Dobrowsky House, at 1720 Yuba Street in Redding. The house, a Craftsman bungalow built in the 1920s, sits on a site acquired by the state in 2012 for the new Redding Courthouse.

Delayed by state budget reductions, the courthouse project is now proceeding. As the project begins architectural design, the state is inviting private-sector market perspectives for possible sale and relocation of this structure. The state seeks ideas to maximize public benefit to the government and taxpayers and contribute to the cultural history and the vitality of downtown Redding before it is necessary to clear the site in anticipation of courthouse construction.
