ORDER

The case is dismissed pursuant to the provisions of Penal Code §§ 1203.4/1203.4a.
2. Request for dismissal is DENIED with prejudice without prejudice. ** If your Petition is denied without prejudice, you may request a hearing.

Notwithstanding dismissal, any prior conviction(s) may be pled and proved as a prior conviction. Nor does this reduction to a misdemeanor (if granted) and/or dismissal relieve you of your administrative duty to provide DNA samples consistent with the requirements of Penal Code §§ 296(a) and 299(f).
